Hello all,

World Wide Data Day 2018 registration is closed. For all whose e-mail address is in the "To" field of this Memo, this is your confirmation. Welcome!

Here's the news:

- We set a record! We have 77 separate registrations from 19 countries. That is about twice as many registrations last year. Thank you all!
- If you go to the <u>W2D2 website</u> you will see that the Registration button is gone and has been replaced by the Videocons button. That takes you to a page that tells you about Vidyo tests and has the Schedule of Videoconferences. (That schedule is now blank but will be pretty much in place before our next Memo in one week.)
- About Vidyo tests: if you had a successful W2D2 videoconference last year using the same location and equipment as you have now, you do not need to do a Vidyo test. You are still welcome to do so, of course. All others do need to have a Vidyo test to assure smooth videooconferences on 15th November.

Also: a question came up about students doing the measurements with iPads. It should be OK but...if you have a chance, please try out iSpy-w2d2 and HYPATIA-w2d2 on your iPads, smart phones, tablets, Chromebooks, etc. and send me an e-mail to let me know how it goes. That will be a big help and we'll report the results in the next Memo

A call to a local newspaper or broadcast outlet is often enough to generate some coverage. And your school officials may be very happy to publicize your participation.
