## Let's start with these:

- <u>Big Analysis of Muons 2021</u> is the home page for teachers. This has information you can use and a timeline to help you schedule.
- The student homes are the <u>ATLAS</u> and <u>CMS</u> pages. These have the information they need to do the measurements, including instructional videos.
- Students should watch the videos for their measurement before attempting the measurement. This is our main vehicle of instruction.
- Teachers are important coaches and organizers for the students. Please watch the same videos before the students do!
- We will have teacher Q&A sessions on Zoom this Friday 21 May, at 11:00 UTC for CMS and 20:00
  UTC for ATLAS. I will send you the Zoom link and password shortly before the meeting to
  maximize security.
- Warning: our servers will be down for maintenance this Friday 12:30-19:00 UTC (right between our Q&A meetings).

You will notice that all times given for BAM are in UTC, not local times. You can convert to your local time using this <u>Time Zone Converter</u>. Please do so!

Finally, data assignments will be ready later today or very early tomorrow. These will be made by <u>institution</u>. It is up to the teacher/professor/leader at the institution to then assign data files to individuals. Thus you will be hearing from me again soon!
